On October 17, 2018, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) (“Great Western” or “Applicant”), filed a verified application (“Application”) pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in five approximate 640-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units, and one approximate 320-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit, established for the above-described Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.

2) Providing that the Commission’s pooling order is made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the Burr FD-23-382HNX Well (API No. Pending) in WSU #1, the Burr FD-23-339HNX Well (API No. Pending) in WSU #2, the Burr FD-23-302HN Well (API No. Pending) in WSU #3, the Burr FD-23-302HNX Well (API No. Pending) in SWU #4, the Burr FD-23-222HNX Well (API No. Pending) in WSU #5, and the Burr FD-23-219HN Well (API No. Pending) in WSU #6 (“Wells”) for the Niobrara Formation.

3) Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of a horizontal well are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to § 34-60-116(6) and (7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof with respect to any horizontal well drilled to develop the Niobrara Formation in the designated horizontal wellbore spacing units comprising the Application Lands.

4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations underlying certain lands, with permitted well locations in accordance with the

provisions of Order No. 407-1.
