NOTICE OF HEARING

On October 17, 2018, HighPoint Operating Corporation (Operator No. 10071) ("HighPoint" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application ("Application") pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Amend Order No. 421-137 to increase the number of wellpads within the approximate 1,280-acre stand-up drilling and spacing unit for Sections 8 and 17, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., from two wellpads to four wellpads, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations;

2) Find that increasing the number of wellpads to four will maximize the efficient and economic production of the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formation on the Application Lands.

3) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

- On October 21, 2010, the Commission entered Order No. 421-3 which, among other things, established 83 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units, and approved one horizontal well within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 8, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. was subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.
- On June 27, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-28 which, among other things, established 52 approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units, and approved one horizontal well within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 17, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. is subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.

- On January 7, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 421-35 which, among other things, vacated two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 421-3 for Sections 5 and 8, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and establish an approximate 1280-acre stand-up exploratory drilling and spacing unit for Sections 5 and 8, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and approve up to ten wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- On January 7, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-226 which vacated the approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-28 for Section 17, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and established an approximate 1280-acre stand-up exploratory drilling and spacing unit for Sections 17 and 20, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and approved one up to ten wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- On September 17, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 421-137 which, among other things, established an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 8 and 17, Township 10 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations; and approve up to sixteen (16) new horizontal wells in the approximate 1,280-acre unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations, with the productive interval of any horizontal well in the unit to be no closer than 150 feet from the boundaries of the unit for the Niobrara and Fort Hays Formations and no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundaries for the Codell and Carlile Formations and 150' inter-well setbacks from any wellbore within the unit, and authorized two wellpads within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara, Fort Hays, Codell, and Carlile Formations underlying the Application Lands.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of December 3, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
