On October 18, 2018 St. Croix Operating, Inc., (Operator No. 81490) ("St. Croix" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1.) Establish an approximate 40-acre drilling and spacing unit ("DSU") for the Application Lands for the J-Sandstone Formation; and
- 2) Drill and complete one vertical well within the unit, with the treated interval of any well in the unit be located no closer than 350 feet from any lease line, and no closer than 600 feet from the treated interval of any other producing well.

- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. Sections 9 and 16, Township 3 South, Range 50 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., are subject to this Rule for the J-Sandstone Formation.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of December 3, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
