APPLICATION

On October 18, 2018, SRC Energy Inc. (Operator No. 10311) ("SRC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Amend Order No. 407-2166 to account for the adjustment to Wellbore Spacing Unit No. 5, the AG 4N-31B-L Well (API No. 05-123-44874), and thereby pool the interests in the Application Lands, being an approximate 771.886-acre wellbore spacing unit for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, effective as of the earlier of the date of Pooling Order No. 407-2166, or the date the costs specific in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the AG 4N-31B-L Well (API No. 05-123-44874).

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule
- On July 24, 2017, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2166 which, among other things, pooled all interests in five approximate 811.886 wellbore spacing units for portions of Sections 31, 32, and 33, Township 6 North, Range 66 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. and portions of Section 36, Township 6 North, Range 67 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
