On October 18, 2018, Noble Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 100322) ("Noble" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application ("Application") pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell, Carlile, Fort Hays and Niobrara Formations.
- 2) Approve up to 16 horizontal wells in the proposed approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell, Carlile, Fort Hays and Niobrara Formations
- 3) Require that the productive interval of each proposed horizontal well shall be no closer than 460 feet on the boundaries of the proposed unit and all horizontal wells shall be no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of another well producing from the same supply within the unit, unless a waiver or consent is obtained from the operator of such well, and to approve no more than two new well pads in the unit, or adjacent thereto, unless an exception is granted by the Director;
- 4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.
