On October 18, 2018, JWM Energy Holdings, LLC ("JWM" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

1) Declaring Applicant's interests in the Shadow Well drilled on the Application Lands are not subject to the cost recovery and risk penalties set forth in Order No. 407-2082, and for such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper.

- On June 12, 2017, the Commission issued Order No. 407-2082 which, among other things, pooled all interests within an approximate 715.96-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units established for the Application Lands, for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, and authorized cost recovery and risk penalties from certain nonconsenting owners for the drilling, completion and operation of the Shadow A26-646 Well.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings\_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of December 3, 2018, if a prehearing conference is requested by the Applicant, or any person who has filed a protest or intervention.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
