On October 31, 2018, Edge Energy II, LLC (Operator No. 10671) ("Edge" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Vacate an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-158 for Section 22, Township 8 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M.;
- 2) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve a total of up to twelve (12) horizontal wells within the unit, with the productive interval of the permitted horizontal wells within the unit located no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other horizontal wellbore within the same common source of supply, and no closer than 300 feet from the unit boundaries, without exception being granted by the Director; and
- 3) Require that the wells be drilled from no more than four surface locations within each unit or on adjacent lands.

- Rule 318.a. provides that for unspaced lands, a well drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth shall be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing.
- On May 29, 2012, the Commission entered Order No. 535-158, which, among other things, established five approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for certain lands in Township 8 and 9 North, Ranges 64 and 65 West, 6th P.M., and approve up to four horizontal wells within each unit, with the treated interval of the permitted wellbores located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, without exception being granted by the Director.
