APPLICATION

On November 16, 2018, Incline Operating, LLC (Operator No. 10689) ("Incline" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 400-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands; and
- 2) Approve up to eight (8) horizontal wells in the proposed unit, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formation, with the treated interval of the wells within the unit located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundary, and no closer than 150 feet from the treated interval of any other wellbore producing from the same common source of supply; and
- 3) Require that the permitted wells within the unit be drilled and operated from no more than one surface locations within the unit, or at legal locations on adjacent lands, without exception being granted by the Director.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On December 22, 2016, the Commission issued Order No. 407-1846, which pooled all interests in two (2) approximate 720-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units established for certain lands in Sections 23, 24, 25, 26, 35 and 36, Township 1 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M.
