On November 29, 2018, Crestone Peak Resources Operating LLC (Operator No. 10633) ("Crestone" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to Rule 318A.e(5)C for an order:

- 1) Granting a hearing on Applicant's thirteen (13) Warner Rule 318A.a(4)D horizontal wellbore spacing units;
- 2) Upon such hearing, approving Applicant's thirteen (13) Warner Rule 318A.a(4)D horizontal wellbore spacing units;
- 3) Upon such hearing, denying Verdad Resources, LLC's Objections to Applicant's thirteen (13) Warner Rule 318A.a(4)D horizontal wellbore spacing units; and
- 4) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells and Rules 318A.a(4)D and 318A.e(5) were adopted.

Rule 318A.e(5) addresses notice and hearing procedures, and allows an operator to seek a hearing before the Commission on an objection.
