# **APPLICATION LANDS**

Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M. Section 34: E½

#### **APPLICATION**

On November 29, 2018, PDC Energy, Inc. (Operator No. 69175) ("PDC" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands and approve up to 2 horizontal wells in the proposed unit, for production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell formations, with the productive interval of any horizontal well permitted under this Application located no less than 150 feet from the north and south unit boundaries, no less than 460 feet from the east and west unit boundaries, drilling with a north-south orientation, and no less than 150 feet from the productive interval of any wellbore within the same unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 2) Require that the wells be drilled from no more than one existing surface location within the unit or on adjacent lands, unless an exception is granted by the Director.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. The Application Lands are subject to this rule for the Niobrara and Codell formations.
- On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell-Niobrara Formations, the Codell Formation, and the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, including the Application Lands, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order 407-1.
- On June 20, 2016, the Commission entered Order No. 407-1720, which, among other things, pooled an approximate 480-acre horizontal wellbore spacing unit for the E½SW¼

and W½SE¼ of Section 27, and the E½W½ and W½E½ of Section 34, all of Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the development of the Chesnut 27O-303 (API No. 05-123-39979) Well from the Niobrara formation. Order No. 407-1720 is not affected by this Application, and proceeds from any shared lands will be accounted for in the production of the Well.
