2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Hendu 23-1HZ Well (API No. 05-123-47262), the Hendu 23-2HZ Well (API No. 05-123-47258), the Hendu 23-3HZ Well (API No. 05-123-47256), and the Hendu 23-4HZ Well (API No. 05-123-47257).


