APPLICATION

On November 29, 2018, Raisa II Operating, LLC and Raisa Energy, LLC (Operator No. 10636) ("Raisa" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in the Application Lands underlying an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit comprising the Application Lands.

2) Subject any non-consenting interests, including any party failing to fulfill its election, to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. are first incurred for the drilling of the following wells Raisa State 27HZNC #1 (API No. 05-123-48707), Raisa State 27HZNC #2 (API No. 05-123-48712), Raisa State 27HZNC #3 (API No. 05-123-48710), Raisa State 27HZNC #4 (API No. 05-123-48718); Raisa State 27HZNC #5 (API No. 05-123-48720), Raisa State 27HZNC #6 (API No. 05-123-48722), Raisa State 27HZNB #1 (API No. 05-123-48711), Raisa State 27HZNB #2 (API No. 05-123-48709), Raisa State 27HZNB #3 (API No. 05-123-48708), Raisa State 27HZNB #4 (API No. 05-123-48717), Raisa State 27HZNB #5 (API No. 05-123-48719), Raisa State 27HZNB #6 (API No. 05-123-48716), Raisa State 27HZC #1 (API No. 05-123-48714), Raisa State 27HZC #2 (API No. 05-123-48715), Raisa State 27HZC #3 (API No. 05-123-48721), and Raisa State 27HZC #4 (API No. 05-123-48713) ("Wells"), for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations in the 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands.

3) For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

APPLICABLE ORDERS AND RULES

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was amended to, among other things, address drilling of horizontal wells but did not prohibit the establishment of drilling and spacing units within the Greater Wattenberg Area.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1. The Application Lands are subject to this Order for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On September 17, 2018, the Commission entered Order No. 407-2582 which established an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for Sections 35 and 36, Township 1 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to twenty-two (22) horizontal wells within the unit, for the efficient and economic development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations.


Additional information about the hearing on this Application will be in the Commission's Agenda, which is posted on the Commission website approximately three days before the hearing.
