At this time, DOE does not request any additional information but would encourage COGCC to place general language in the permit such that the company would accommodate DOE sampling requests in the future. DOE agrees with the COGCC assessment that the pad is located approximately

1.9 miles from the Rulison site at the NESE of Section 19 7S 94W, and the bottom-hole-locations range approximately from 1.5 to 2.1 miles from Project Rulison. Accordingly, DOE agrees with COGCC that all wells fall under the Tier 2 sampling and monitoring of the COGCC Rulison Sample and Analysis Plan and are located in Sector 2 or 3 of the Rulison SAP. DOE will continue to review the proposed locations and subsurface orientations of the propose drilling for documentation when sampling occurs. Noble has submitted permits for a new pad in the Project Rulison 3 mile area.

The surface location is in the NESE Section 19 7S 94W, approximately 1.9 miles from the project well.

There are permits for 13 wells with bottom hole locations in Sections 19 and 20 7S 94W, approximately 1.5 to 2.1 miles from the project well.


All the wells are in Tier 2 of the Project Rulison Sampling and Analysis Plan.

Twelve (12) of the wells are in Sector 2 and one well, the 20-14A is very close to the line between Sectors 2 & 3.

The permits include a letter from Noble to Jack dated October 30, 2009.
