Don,  
Attached are the BMPs that CPW are recommending for the Pirtlaw 24-33 well pad.  
These BMPs are voluntary and CPW would like you to acknowledge that you accept them, or not. If you do accept them please respond to all that you agree to follow them. After I receive your response I will follow up with the COGCC permit comments and get it done today.

Please let me know if you have any questions or need clarification.

- 1) Quicksilver will construct and drill the pad and well outside of the period between March 1 and July 30.
- 2) Quicksilver will construct and or drill any subsequent wells outside the period between March 1 and July 30.

- 3) Quicksilver will conduct post-development well site visitations between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. and reduce well site visitations between March 1 and July 30 in sharp-tail lek and production areas.
- 4) Quicksilver agrees to use hospital grade mufflers for compressors, pump jacks or other motors necessary to run operations at the site. Mufflers will be pointed upward to dissipate potential vibration.
- 5) Interim and final reclamation will match existing vegetation.
- 6) Quicksilver will include a weed management plan and implement the plan as part of reclamation.
