This is to inform you that LPEA will be relocating the power line and converting a portion of it to underground, under the terms and conditions of LPEA's Line Extension Policy (found on our website at <http://www.lpea.coop>), in order to allow for the installation of the referenced wells, located in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 17, Township 32 North, Range 5 West, N.M.P.M., in Archuleta County, Colorado. A portion of the power line will be converted to underground so that no portion of the overhead line is within 150' of the well head(s).
