The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#2287319) for the Kuenzler & Flora Reserve Co location, located in the NENE Sec 36 T12S R46W Cheyenne county, Colorado. The COGCC requests recognition of the conditions of approval and changes to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

Sensitive Area Determination

Based on the close proximity of surface water the location is considered a sensitive area. The sensitive area tab has been changed to yes.

Conditions of approval

Operator must implement site-specific best management practices in accordance with good engineering practices, including, but not limited to, construction of a berm or diversion dike, site grading, or other comparable measures, sufficient to protect the ephemeral stream located Approximately 38 feet north east of the oil and gas location from a release of drilling, completion, produced fluids, and chemical products.
