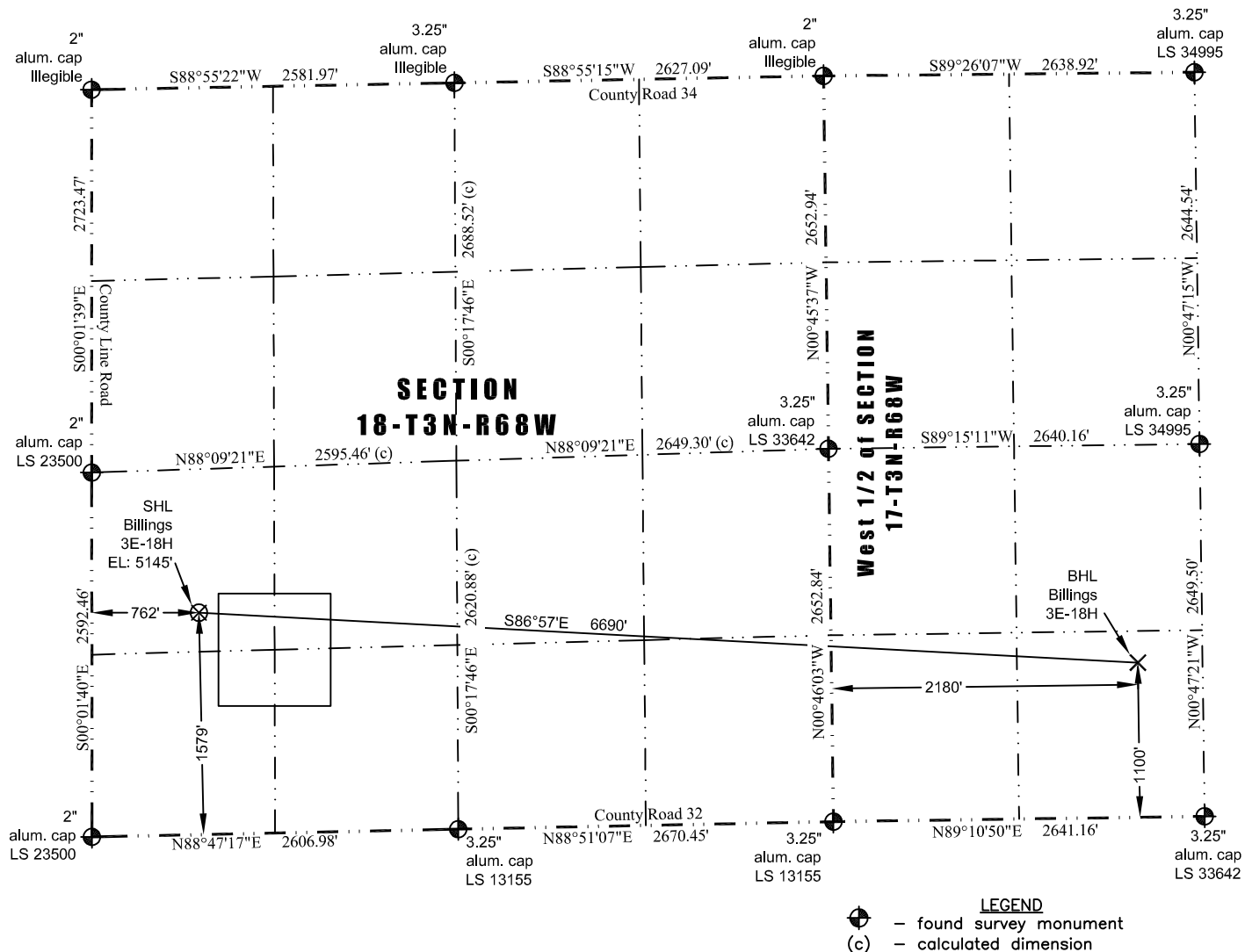

In accordance with a request from Jay Knutson of EnCana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc., JR Land Surveying, LLC has determined the location of the **Billings 3E-18H** well site to be SHL: 1579' FSL and 762' FWL, (BHL: 1100' FSL and 2180' FWL) as measured at ninety (90) degrees from the section lines of Section 18 and Section 17, Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th Principal Meridian, County of Weld, CO.
