The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado has called a hearing to consider the petition of the Shell Oil Company for an order providing for forty-acre drilling and spacing units according to the Governmental survey thereof for the "D" Sand common source of supply and the "J" Sand, common source of supply, underlying the E 1/2 of section 23, the E 1/2 of section 26, all of sections 24 and 25 in Township 5 North, Range 61 West, Weld County, Colorado, and the W 1/2 of section 19 and the W 1/2 of section 30, Township 5 North, Range 60 West, Morgan County, Colorado, which area is presently referred to as the Masters Field.  
All operators and owners of working interests or minerals and all persons interested in said field are hereby notified by the State of Colorado, as represented by the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, that the above-entitled matter has been set for hearing before the Commission on:
