| PITS            | JOHN NOTO          | <p>Former employee of CM Productions contacted COGCC and said he was directed by CM Production, to bury a skim pit at the production facility. The former employee indicated that no samples were collected, that E&amp;P waste (oily) was in pit, and a Form 27 was not filled out.</p> <p>J. Noto - phone conversation with Mr. Parks on 11/11/13. Mr. Parks stated he was directed by John Teff, (on record as Business Manager of CM Production) to pump water and leave oil and mud in pits. Pits reportedly buried in 2011. Review of aerial photos by J. Noto revealed skim pits present in 2009 and not present in 2011. COGCC conducted site inspection on 11/20/13. No documents for pit closure found in COGCC database.</p> |
