I have identified pit facility id 116724 as a historical pit that was associated with this location. I have updated our database and pit location.

Can you provide the following information:

Was pit bottom sample taken from the area in the pit (from figure 2) that appears silty and void of vegetation?

Mr. Kris Rowe says, "Yes, the same was collected from the silty area where no vegetation was collected (which is also the lowest point of the pit required per rule)."

Could you identify the blowdown source of the pit and plot on map (or picture)?

Pictures included in Form 27 report.

It appears that the pit is still open and awaiting closure approval. If this is the case, please specifically request closure of pit facility 116724.

Form 27 was revised to show pit facility 116724.

The cleanest way to submit this would be to revise the Form 27 (so the requested information is in one document) and submit on a sundry.
