RE: Robertson 1-31 Gas Well - House Gas Line

Dear Mr. Robertson:

On May 2, 2017 the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) issued a Notice To Operators (NTO) directing all operators to first inventory and then test all flowlines within 1000' of an occupied building or home. This NTO was issued to all operators statewide as a result of the Firestone incident. Petron Development Company has completed both the inspections and testing of all lines within the 1000' criteria that are under our control.

During the initial inspection process the "house gas" line attached to our well and belonging to you and under your control was inventoried and reported to the COGCC. This was phase 1 of the NTO. As stated above, phase 2 required pressure testing of all lines subject to the NTO. Given that Petron neither owns nor controls your "house gas" line, we are without authority to conduct any sort of testing for integrity on this line.

Petron recommends you perform an integrity test of your line at your earliest convenience. In addition, should you own or be in control of any unused natural gas risers, Petron recommends removing these at your earliest convenience consistent with phase 2 of the NTO. Of course, Petron is not a law firm, so our recommendation should in no way be construed as legal advice. We simply write to provide you a courtesy notice regarding the NTO, and to emphasize that Petron will not pressure test your "house gas" line, as Petron does not own or control the "house gas" line beyond the point of the ball valve at the wellhead.
