I don't think the well is due for another MIT until 1/21/2020. The last MIT was 1/21/15. As long as the well remains SI the MIT is good for 5 years. If the well becomes TA you would need one within 6 months and a Sundry for continued TA status.

Magpie is due to MIT this well by Monday, April 16th. We currently have devoted all available resources to a couple of NOAV CA's in Washington County. We are looking to bring in a contract rig to perform the work on the Safranek, but so far have not located one. We are beginning plugging operations in Washington County on just one well. Can we get an extension on the CA date for the Safranek MIT? If we locate another rig, we will bring it in ASAP, otherwise I believe we can MIT the Safranek by April 30th.
