I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and have the following comments.

- 1) In the Construction section Confluence DJ has indicated the size of the location after interim reclamation will be 7.5 acres. A review of the Proposed Reclamation Map, which was included as part of the Construction Layout Drawings, indicates 7.5 acres will be reclaimed resulting in 9.4 acres after interim reclamation. Please confirm the planned size of the location after interim reclamation.
- 2) In the Water Resources section Confluence DJ has indicated the nearest water well is 2,269 feet away. This appears to be water well Permit #66488 which the Colorado DWR has mapped immediately west of your proposed Pickaroon North location. As discussed in my recent correspondence concerning the Pickaroon North Form 2A, I suspect this water well either no longer exists or was poorly mapped when it was permitted. The next closest water well is Permit #154419 located approximately 3,100 feet to the southeast. Therefore, I would like to change the distance to the nearest water well to 3,100 feet.

Brittany & Andrea,

I have reviewed the referenced Form 2A Oil & Gas Location Assessment and have the following comments.

1) In the Construction section Confluence DJ has indicated the size of the location after interim reclamation will be 7.5 (should be 9.4 ac) acres. A review of the Proposed Reclamation Map, which was included as part of the Construction Layout Drawings, indicates 7.5 acres will be reclaimed resulting in 9.4 acres after interim reclamation. Please confirm the planned size of the location after interim reclamation. **Doug – the size of the location after interim reclamation will be 9.4 acres (long term disturbed area). The total reclaimed acreage will be 7.5 acres. Total construction disturbance will be (9.4 ac + 7.5 ac) = 16.9 ac**

2) In the Water Resources section Confluence DJ has indicated the nearest water well is 2,269 feet away. This appears to be water well Permit #66488 which the Colorado DWR has mapped immediately west of your proposed Pickaroon North location. As discussed in my recent correspondence concerning the Pickaroon North Form 2A, I suspect this water well either no longer exists or was poorly mapped when it was permitted. The next closest water well is Permit #154419 located approximately 3,100 feet to the southeast. Therefore, I would like to change the

distance to the nearest water well to 3,100 feet. **Doug – per Andrea’s response to this very question you had on the Pickaroon North location, you are correct about the water well permit #66488 being incorrectly mapped or no longer existing. Please change the distance to the nearest water well to 3,100’.**
