
RE: Bristol Resources Proposed

Gentlemen:

Energy Partners Nominee Company has a leasehold interest in the N/2 of Section 6-T18S-R41W and the S/2 of Section 31-T17S-R41W which is contiguous to the location of the captioned well. We object to the proposal of Bristol Resources to convert the Leathers "B" #3 well to a saltwater disposal well injecting saltwater into the Morrow formation. We believe the injection of saltwater may be detrimental to the existing and future production from the Morrow zone which is produced out of a number of wells in the vicinity of the Leathers "B" #3 well. We were not contacted by Bristol Resources concerning their original request; therefore, we apologize for the delay in our response. We request the matter either be set for hearing or denied.
