The Ramey No. 4 was completed as an oil well in April, 1952, in the "J" sand. The reservoir produces by active water drive. This well experienced water breakthrough in mid-1956, and oil production has declined to the present rate of 4 B0 & 22 BW. Perforation of additional "J" sand in October, 1959, only slightly increased oil production. The production history of this well indicates that the oil pay is depleted and further attempts to restore production are not warranted. There are no other potential pay zones in the well. This well will not be needed for secondary or tertiary recovery as the reservoir is not a candidate for such operations. Therefore, it is recommended that Ramey No. 4 be plugged and abandoned.

The well has been sold for salvage to Bovaird Supply Company, Great Bend, Kansas.
