Dear Sir:

A recent field inspection of your firm's Windsong #4 well revealed that pits associated with the drilling of the well have not been properly backfilled. It was also obvious that two of the pits were being used as receptacles for illegal wastewater disposal. As this illegal practice will not be tolerated by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission we must demand that all pits be backfilled and the site restored to its original condition (except for necessary production equipment) by September 1, 1988.

Cavanaugh & Cavanaugh, Inc. must also submit proper forms and well logs required by the Commission regarding this well. We require that Form 5 (Well Completion Report), Form 10 (Certification of Clearance), any production data, and logs be forwarded to our office immediately.

The Commission considers these violations and omissions to be quite serious. My supervisors are aware of the situation and are prepared to take necessary action in the event of noncompliance by your firm. Immediate correction of these problems would be in the best interest of all concerned.
