A loading error resulted in approximately 12 bbls of produced water being released to the ground surface from a load line. The release was completely contained to the pad. The impacted soil will be removed and hauled to a COGCC approved disposal facility. Confirmation soil samples will be collected and submitted for laboratory analysis in compliance with full Table 915-1. Analytical results will be provided in a subsequent report.

While conducting work on the LACT, a third-party contractor did not properly blind the influent produced water load line. A water hauler arrived on location and began loading operations allowing approximately 12 bbls of produced water to be released to the ground surface outside containment.

A formal root cause analysis is being conducted with the contractor to discuss the importance of utilizing proper blinding, and lock out tag out procedures.
