Items Agreed to:

- P&A Peterson 14-20 – Plug in accordance with Colorado Carbon and Energy Management Commission Rules and Regulations.
- Flowlines – Purge, thread and cap flowline in place in accordance with Colorado Carbon and Energy Management Commission Rules and Regulations.
- Electrical – Leave underground electrical in place. Confirmed that there are no meters or above ground equipment on location. Remove any above ground equipment and close any accounts.
- Access Road – Leave Access Road operational and turn over maintenance to City of Thornton.
- Revegetation – Prospect agrees to follow City of Thornton standards and vegetation mix (attached).
- Environmental – Perform environmental sampling as required by Colorado Carbon and Energy Management Commission Rules and Regulations including completing Form 27.
- Fences – Remove any internal fences associated with and exclusive to the Peterson 14-20 Well.
- Gate – Leave the gate off the County Road and remove any locks used by Prospect Energy.
- Remove any pipelines, electrical lines, or other facilities that are not deep enough to be avoided by normal farming operations.
