GENTLEMEN:

A wellsite inspection on 4-16-92 revealed that plugging work on the above captioned well is incomplete. The following marked conditions were observed to exist at the time of inspection.

- ☐ Risers left above ground, junk and debris on site
- ☐ Cement pad or gravel left on site
- ☒ Anchors left in ground
- ☐ Pit open
- ☐ Surface casing not cut off 4' b.g.l. and capped
- ☐ Well improperly plugged and leaking
- ☒ Surface restoration incomplete
- ☐ Equipment left on site must be removed.

Comments:

Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission  
Rule 319 requires abandoned sites to be cleared of equipment and restored within a reasonable time not to exceed six months from the plugging date. The well was plugged 1-27-92  
Please notify this office in writing of your intentions for compliance within 30 days of the above date.
