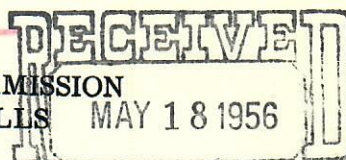

Reopened old hole down to 2800 feet and run 15 sack cement  
 plug. Top at 2770 feet. Run in 2 3/8 tubing and cemented  
 with 25 sacks from 2770 feet up to 2600 feet and  
 perforated as per attached copy of shooting. On swab test  
 we recovered approximately 5 gallons of oil and 50 gallons  
 of water. Not commercial pulled tubing at 2550 feet. The  
 plug was run in at 175 feet the bottom of the surface  
 and the top capped and abandoned.
