Attached are the OGCC Form 4's for the CF & I 29 #1 and #2 wells.

These two wells were drilled into the Vermejo coal seams in Las Animas County, Colorado to determine if commercial production of methane gas was possible from these coal seams.

The coal seams were thin and had low gas content which indicated there was not a good possibility of developing commercial production of methane under current economic conditions.

The project has been terminated and the wells are to be turned over to CF & I to be used as water wells at a later date.
